Keep your baggage in view especially in the public places and inside the means of transport.



Always lock your vehicle and never keep valuables and passport inside.



Don't carry large amounts of cash, valuables or expensive jewellery with you. Be aware of people around you when using ATMs and hide your PIN. Keep a copy of your passports and other travel documents.



If you get drunk, get a friend to take you to the hotel or get a taxi. Look after your friend and make sure they get to the hotel safely after drinking alcohol.

If anything does go wrong and you need assistance, become the victim of a crime or lose your travel documents then attend at the **TOURIST POLICE VISITORS' HELP OFFICE.**

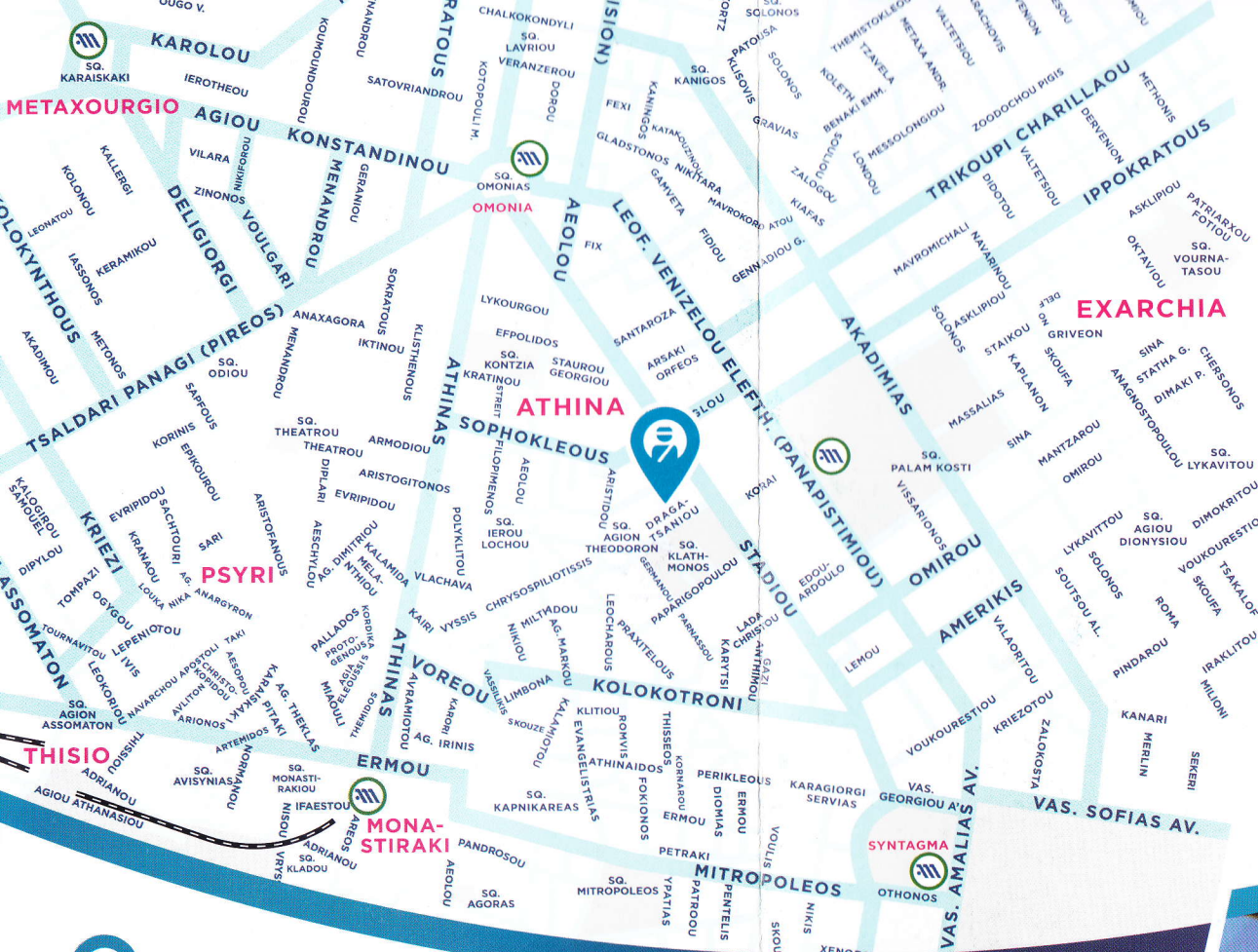
